The Hendersonville Middle School bands are directed by Samuel L. (Buddy) Gudger. Mr. Gudger received his Bachelor of Music Degree from Mars Hill College and Master of the Arts In Educational Leadership from Gardner Webb University. He started his career in southeastern North Carolina teaching band in Duplin and Brunswick Counties. During that time, Mr. Gudger served on the Board of Directors and is a past President of the Southeastern District Bandmasters Association. Buddy was selected as Teacher of the Year (1996-1997) for South Brunswick High School.

In the fall of 2000, Mr. Gudger returned to his hometown of Asheville and began teaching at Hendersonville Middle School. He was named Teacher of the Year (2005-2006). In addition, Mr. Gudger is a recipient of the North Carolina Award of Excellence for the Western District (2009). Under Mr. Gudger’s direction, the Hendersonville Middle School 8th grade band performed at the North Carolina Music Educator’s Conference in Winston-Salem (2014). He has served as a clinician for several honor bands and as an adjudicator for MPA. Mr. Gudger is a member of NCAE, NAFME, WNCBA and the American School Band Director’s Association. Mr. Gudger plays trumpet in the Asheville Community Band, sings with the Montmorenci United Methodist Church Choir, the Hominy Valley Men’s Choir, and is often asked to play at funerals for local veterans. He and his wife Connie reside in Candler, North Carolina with their daughter Celia.

Mr. Workman was also selected as "Teacher of the Year" for the 2011-2012 school year and was selected to receive an "Encore Award" from the prestigious American School Band Directors Association in the same year. He has been the Dean of Men at the Western North Carolina/Mars Hill College Summer Music Camp since 2005. Mr. Workman is active in the Northwest District Bandmasters Association where he serves as the Middle School Audition Site Host, the High School All State Clinic Chair and as a district representative on the State MPA Committee. About Dr. Jack Stamp:

Dr. Jack Stamp is currently adjunct Professor of Music at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls where he teaches conducting and is chairperson of the music department. Prior to this appointment, Dr. Stamp served as Director of Band Studies at Indiana University of Pennsylvania for 25 years. He holds a DMA degree in Wind Conducting from Michigan State University where he studied with Eugene Corporon. Prior to his retirement from IUP, he served as chairman of the Division of Fine Arts at Campbell University in North Carolina. In addition to these posts, Dr. Stamp served as conductor of the Duke University Wind Symphony (1988-89) and was musical director of the Triangle British Brass Band.

In 1996, he received the Orpheus Award from the Zeta Tau Chapter of Phi Mu Alpha for service to music and was named a "Distinguished Alumnus" of Indiana University of Pennsylvania. In 1999, he received the "Citation of Excellence" from the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association. In 2000, he was inducted into the prestigious American Bandmasters Association. He was awarded the title of "University Professor" for the 2008-2009 academic year at IUP. This is the highest award the university gives to a professor.

Dr. Stamp is founder and conductor of the Keystone Winds, an ensemble dedicated to the performance of American band music. He resides in Hudson, WI with his wife, LeAnn.
