About Mrs. Katie Ebert:

Katie Ebert is the Director of Bands at Cuthbertson Middle School in Waxhaw, NC, having served in this capacity since the school's opening in 2009. Under Mrs. Ebert's baton, the Cuthbertson Middle School concert bands have consistently earned superior ratings at local, district and regional music festivals. The band program has grown to a current enrollment of 340 music students. Mrs. Ebert also serves as the Assistant Director of Bands at Cuthbertson High School. Mrs. Ebert is in her 15th year teaching public school. In 2012 and 2017, the Cuthbertson Middle School 8th grade band was a performing ensemble at the NCMEA state convention and in 2017 her band performed at the University of Georgia MidFest clinic. Mrs. Ebert has directed or assisted with ensemble performances at Music for All's National Concert Band Festival, the NCMEA state convention, Festival Disney, the Percy Grainger Festival, the Southern Star Music Festival, Universal Studios Theme Park festivals and the Carowinds Music Festival.

Mrs. Ebert holds a Master of Music Education degree from Western Carolina University in Cullowhee, NC and a Bachelor of Music Education, as well as a Bachelor of Music Performance degree, from Armstrong Atlantic State University in Savannah, GA. Mrs. Ebert is a graduate of Lassiter High School in Marietta, GA, where she served as section leader in the Lassiter Trojan Marching Band and as principal clarinet in the Lassiter Symphonic Band. She is a member of Pi Kappa Lambda and holds professional associations in the National Band Association, the National Association for Music Educators, the North Carolina Music Educators Association, the South Central District Bandmasters Association and the Union County Bandmasters Association. Mrs. Ebert was awarded the National Band Association's Citation of Excellence in 2015 and was recognized as Cuthbertson Middle School's Teacher of the Year in 2016/2017. She currently serves as a district representative on the state MPA committee. Mrs. Ebert serves as a North Carolina adjudicator and a clarinet performer. She resides in Waxhaw, NC and team teaches the Cuthbertson band program alongside her husband, Todd.

About Mr. Jay Bocook:

A native of Clearwater, Florida, Jay Bocook is recognized internationally as a composer, arranger, conductor and educator. Bocook's work has been performed at the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles, the 1996 Centennial Olympic Games in Atlanta, and the 2002 Winter Olympic Games in Salt Lake City, Utah. In 2003, his music transcriptions of noted film composer John Williams were premiered by the U.S. Marine Band in a concert at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C. An encore performance with Williams and the "President's Own" took place in 2008. In addition, Bocook was a contributing arranger to a musical called "CyberJam" that opened to rave reviews in 2003 at London's Queens Theater. His arrangements were also featured in "Mix", which opened in 2008 in Japan.

In 1982, Bocook was appointed director of bands at Furman. He left the school in 1989 to pursue other opportunities, but returned in 2000 as director of athletic bands. He has served as assistant conductor of the Greenville Symphony Orchestra and remains a principal composer and arranger for Hal Leonard Corporation, where he has published over 600 compositions and arrangements. He is the music arranger for the 10-time World Champion Cadets Drum and Bugle Corps. In 2009, Bocook was inducted into the Drum Corps International Hall of Fame. He is also a member of the American Bandmasters Association.

About Dr. Jerry Markoch:

Dr. Jerry Markoch is currently in his 33rd year of teaching and 25th year as Director of Bands at Athens Drive High School in Raleigh, NC. During his tenure at Athens Drive, the band program has grown to over 200 members and has earned significant honors, including consistent "Superior" ratings at the NC Concert Band Festival and numerous "Grand Champion" and "First Place" awards at local and regional marching band events. In April 2017, the Wind Ensemble earned the distinction of being named as "Honor Band of North Carolina"; in March 2014, the Wind Ensemble performed in Carnegie Hall, NY; in 2009 and 2010, concert groups performed for the Music for All/Bands of America "National Concert Band and Percussion Ensemble Festival" in Indianapolis, IN; and in 2006, 2010, 2014, and 2018 the Wind Ensemble performed at the NCMEA Conference in Winston-Salem. The Athens Drive Marching Band has traveled extensively, performing in Tampa, Florida (2018 Outback Bowl Pregame and Parade Grand Champion); Philadelphia (2014 Thanksgiving Day Parade); Washington DC (2012 Memorial Day Parade) and Walt Disney World. Students in the band have received much praise for their enthusiasm, fine character and outstanding musicianship.

Dr. Markoch completed a PhD in Music Education at Louisiana State University, a MM at Bowling Green State University, Ohio, and a BM at the University of Akron, Ohio. Prior to his graduate studies, he served three years as Band Director at Manchester High School (Akron, Ohio). Dr. Markoch has received many awards for his scholarship including a prestigious fellowship at LSU and the distinction of Valedictorian at the University of Akron. In 2003, he was selected by his colleagues as "Teacher of the Year" at Athens Drive High School. In 2007, he was named "Band Director of the Year" by the NC Central District Bandmasters Association and in 2008, he received the "Award of Excellence". In 2015, Dr. Markoch was awarded the Jackson Parkhurst Award for Special Achievement in Music Education from the North Carolina Symphony.

In addition to his teaching responsibilities at Athens Drive, Dr. Markoch has served as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the state. "Doc", as he is affectionately known by his students and colleagues, is an avid golfer and resides in Fuquay-Varina with his wife, Susan. The couple has two children, Ben—a professional graphic designer, and Caroline—a dance educator.
