

SEMPA 2019 Information & Procedures

We are looking forward to having you attend Solo & Ensemble MPA!

- A resource officer will be on duty during the day.
- Band boosters and volunteers will have name tags on for you to identify them if you need help for any reason. Students need to follow the directions of any volunteer serving as a monitor. Please go over behavior expectations with your students.
- Concessions will be available. Food and beverages are not allowed in the gym.
- The director's hospitality room will be located in the media center.

Before you leave your school, please have the items on the checklist with you. Check your address for Lincolnton MS! iMaps is not accurate!

Plan to arrive 30 minutes before your school's block of time. See logistics map for guidelines on traffic flow and parking. Please make sure your group is together in the gym at least 15 minutes before their block of time to perform.

Warm-up takes place in the gym. Students are to go directly into the gym with chaperones while the director registers. Restrooms are available inside of the gym.

Students are allowed to loiter only in the gym and concession area. Food is not to leave the concession area. Please cover proper etiquette and respect for others' property with your students. Please make sure you have covered expectations with your chaperones as well.

Students may go to perform at your assigned performance time. There will be no announcement, so this is up to the band director to be sure that you go at your allotted time. Students are not to play in the halls. Band directors, please be attentive of the hallways. If they are crowded, please assist us by doing crowd control and/or holding some of your students in the gym until the hallways clear.

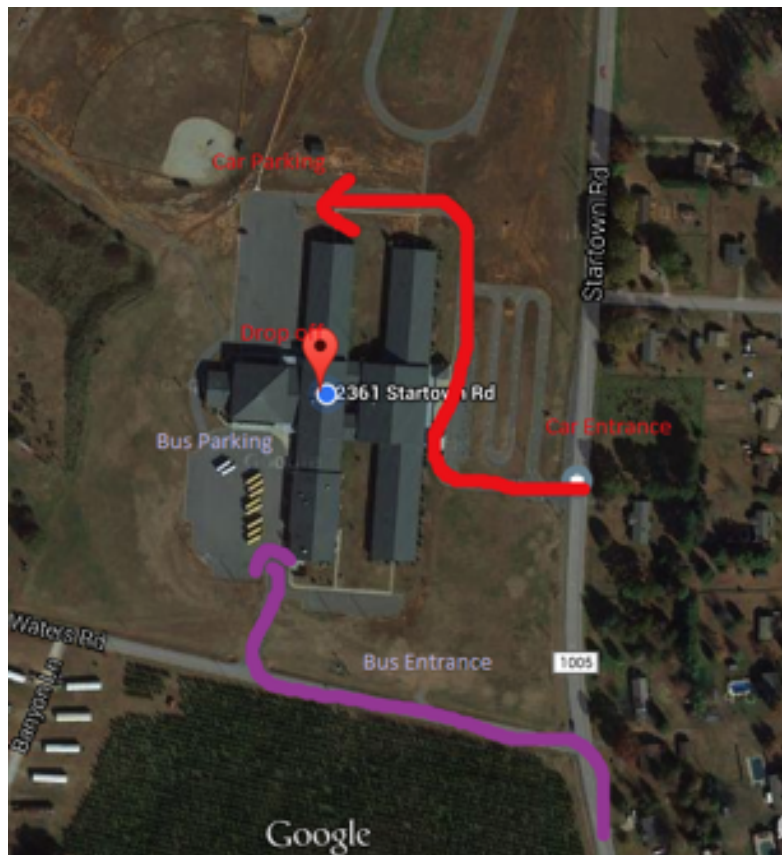
As a soloist or ensemble enters a judge's room, the **judge's music** (preferably an original) and **judge's adjudication sheet** should be ready to be given to the judge. Upon completion of the performance, a runner will take the original music and judge's sheet to the library. Performers should report back to the gym.

The band director should collect music, judge's sheets, and certificates about 15-20 minutes after **all** students from the school have been adjudicated.

SEMPA Traffic Map

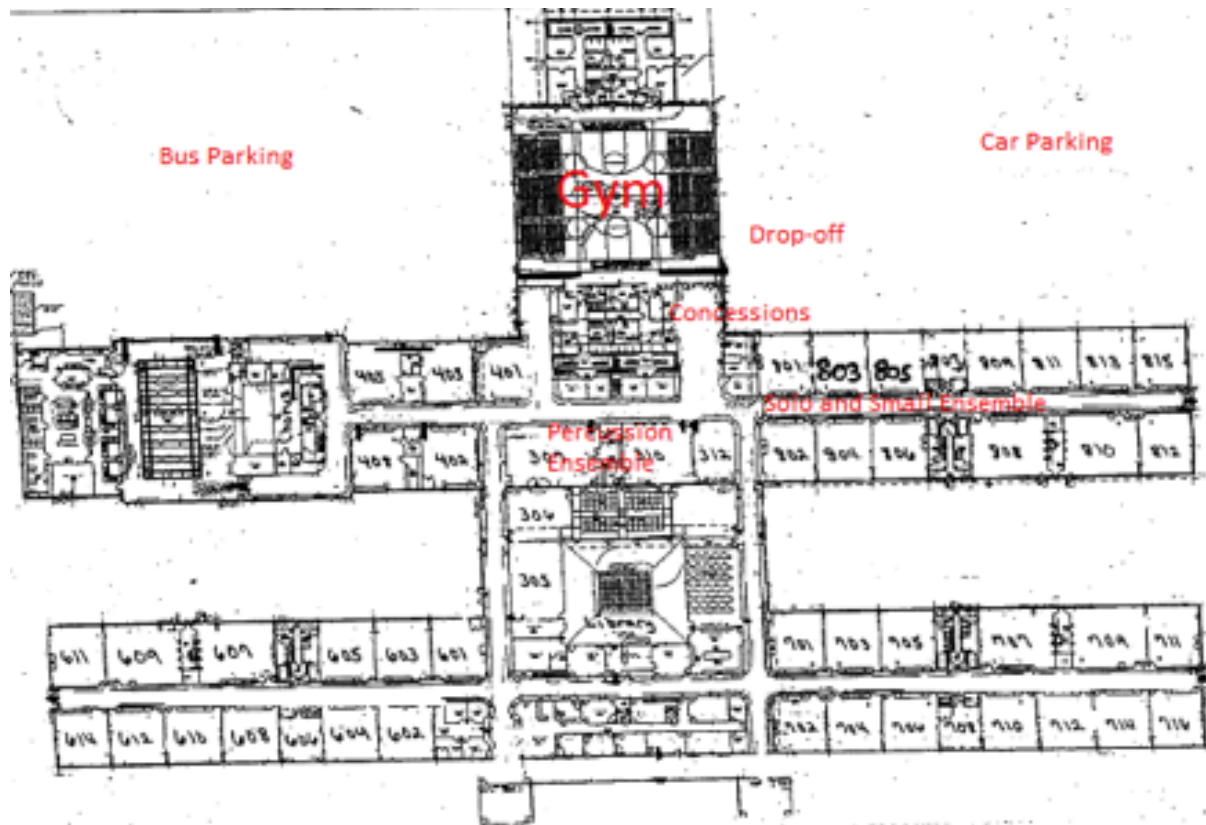

- ***Band room - 309** - will have the following percussion equipment available for percussion ensembles: marimba, vibraphone, xylophone, bells, chimes, 4 timpani, bass drum.
- ***Art room - 310** - will have a marimba and xylophone for percussion solos or smaller ensembles.
- ***Chorus room - 314** - will have a piano available for accompaniment.
- *Other performance rooms will be located on the 800 hall, to the left when you exit the gym.
- *Sound system with CD player and an auxiliary cord for recorded accompaniment will be available – this will be noted on the sign outside of the rooms.
- *There **WILL NOT** be SmartMusic accompaniment available. You should bring your own technology if you choose to use SmartMusic.

 -  9. Take exit 17 for US-321 N

 -  10. Use any lane to turn left onto US-321 N/N Chester St
 Continue to follow US-321 N

 -  11. Keep left to stay on US-321 N

 -  12. Take exit 28 for US-321 BUS toward Maiden

Continue on US-321 BUS S/Maiden Hwy. Take Clark Creek Rd to Startown Rd

-  13. Turn left onto US-321 BUS S/Maiden Hwy (signs for U.S. 321 Business S)

 -  14. Turn right onto Clark Creek Rd

 -  15. Turn right onto Startown Rd
